

# Fuller Meaning of the Number 19

## ק KOPH

ק KOPH is the 19th letter of the Hebrew alphabet and is the symbol of the back of man's head, with the idea being portrayed as that of 'following after or behind' or to 'follow in a circuit or cycle'. KOPH/qôp̄/qoph is the original Hebrew word for apes in Scripture and means ape and monkey (#H6971). Apes and monkeys are known for mimicking or following what you do, hence the expression "monkey see monkey do". The letter koppa or qoppa in ancient Greek form was  $\text{Ϟ}/\text{ϟ}$  and derived from the Phoenician qoph  $\text{ϕ}$ . Koppa is the source of the Latin Q and is the upper case Q and lower case q in English.

The letter ק KOPH extends down below the base line, signifying death and also the tail of the monkey where it follows behind the head. It indicates the need for man to overcome his wild, animalistic tendencies and to emulate the image of God he is made in, realizing his true spiritual nature beyond the sinful flesh.

The letter KOPH consists of two Hebrew letters: ז ZAIN (symbolized by a sword or (axe, as in qardôm)) and ר RESH (meaning head). More specifically, RESH is bent over in humility, rendered to God, in awareness of the need for dependence on Him and the allowance for His way in our lives torn in pieces. Therefore, it is also viewed as the head bent over from its burdens and weight in sin and affliction. It has to do with the redemptive side of God, in that no matter how far out someone goes, God can still save his soul. He can take the worst of situations, turn them around for His good, and use it for His glory and purposes in His righteousness. The letter KOPH begins the Hebrew word qâdôsh (#H6918), which means sacred, holy, sanctuary, angel, saint, set apart, and Holy One.

### *The Monkeys of Martyrdom*

**19** = 10 (order) + 9 (judgment) — Examples: COVID-19 & **Monkeypox**

In all of Scripture, apes/monkeys are mentioned in only 2 verses: 1 Kings 10:22 and 2 Chronicles 9:21 (10 + 9 = **19**). It was soon after COVID-19 was released in 2019 that many people began unleashing their inhibitions in the way of increasingly primal and animalistic behaviors. When man continues to make bad choices, he eventually becomes a lower form of life, like that of an animal, making monkeys of themselves.

### ***God's Instrument to Subdue the Untamed***

The two times apes are mentioned in Scripture are in relation to king Solomon's navy of Tharshish who bring apes to him once every three years. King Solomon built the first temple to the Lord in Jerusalem. The **Antichrist** will stand in the third temple that the Jewish people have begun organizing to build in Jerusalem.

#### **1 Kings 10:14,15**

Now the weight (#H4948 *heaviness* "burden") of gold that came to Solomon in one year was six hundred threescore and six (666) talents (#H3603 *a circle, large (round) coin*) of gold, Beside that he had of the merchantmen, and of traffick (#H4536 *trade, merchandise*) of the spice merchants, and of all the kings of Arabia, and of the governors of the country.

### ***Juneteenth Is on June 19th & the Day of the Crash Was on June 19, 2019***

Juneteenth has been celebrated annually on June 19th in various parts of the United States since 1865 ( $1 + 8 = 9$  &  $6 + 5 = 11$ —\*9/11 and 9-1-1). Juneteenth (officially Juneteenth National Independence Day, Emancipation Day, Freedom Day, and Black Independence Day) is a federal holiday in the United States, commemorating the emancipation of African-American slaves. It was recognized as a federal holiday on June 17, 2021 (6/17/2021,  $6 + 1 + 7 + 2 + 0 + 2 + 1 = 19$ ) when President Joe Biden signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act into law.

The number 19 is the number of freedom for the captives of sin, oppression, and affliction by an extinguishing or subduing of passion or selfishness—in that Jesus Christ was crucified to the flesh for us, and those that are Christ's have crucified the flesh, which is the original Greek word stauroō (#G4717,  $4 + 7 + 1 + 7 = 19$ ). In the Scriptures, there is also the original Greek work hypotassō (#G5293,  $5 + 2 + 9 + 3 = 19$ ), meaning to be under obedience, subdued unto, in subjection under, and submission unto.

### ***Militarily and Non-militarily***

\*The word hypotassō was a Greek military term meaning "to arrange [troop divisions] in a military fashion under the command of a leader". \*In a non-military use, it was "a voluntary attitude of going in, cooperating, assuming responsibility, and carrying a burden".

### ***The Number 18 and Minor to Major Age Threshold***

The legal definition of a minor in the state of Florida, and in general, is under the age of 18. Therefore, the age of majority is reached at 18 years of age, where the threshold of adulthood is recognized or declared in law. It is the moment when minors cease to be considered such and assume legal control over their person, actions, and decisions; thus

terminating the control and legal responsibilities of their parent(s) or guardian(s) over them.

At just 15 years of age upon her passing, **our daughter** was still a minor and under our care, of which we failed her miserably. Consequently, she understandably stated that she wanted to be emancipated from our family. She left it all behind for the Lord. In God's grace and mercy, she was turned in righteousness. And, in His perfect justice, she was freed from captivity and the bondage of sin that she got entangled in, which was mostly all in an effort to appease the pain of the injustice in her afflictions and weight in heavy burdens placed on her, and brought into life more abundantly in eternity.

The letter ק KOPH, in the order of the Hebrew alphabet written from right to left, is unique in that it is the only letter facing to the right and in the opposite direction. As the 19th letter, the KOPH has its back turned toward the 20th letter ר RESH, also meaning the **wicked** (as in the Hebrew words **resha/reša** and **râshâ/rāšā** #H7562-3), and face turned toward the 18th letter צ TZADDI (as in the Hebrew word **tsaddîyq/sadîq** #H6662), meaning the **righteous**. In this way, **Isabella** had her face turned in righteousness as she transitioned on the 19th of June at 12:20 a.m., just after the 18th, and was not to see the 20th. The ק KOPH, being in the middle, also represents the holiness of God at His Second Coming when He comes to judge the wicked and the righteous where the righteous will be placed on His right and the wicked on His left.

In Hebrew gematria, ק KOPH has the numerical value of 100. Isabella was the 100th sheep that went astray, turned back, and was rescued (**res-q**) from further offenses and oppression as she was brought home into safety in Jesus Christ. (\*savior #H3467 means *to be free, defend, deliver(er), help, preserve, rescue, be safe, bring (having) salvation, save(-iour), get victory*). It is my strong belief and firm conviction that our daughter received her **full** reward, while we received **full** retribution in God's justice for the harm she suffered.

## *Cycles*

The Hebrew word **qōdeš** (#H6944) means holiness, and **hakafah** means *to circle around* or *cycle*. Therefore, the letter KOPH has these two meanings: holiness and cycles. The hole of an axe has the meaning of a circle or cycle. Life is cyclical. Also, man moves through cycles of growth in their relationship with God.

## *The Eye of a Needle*

The KOPH is also representative of the ‘eye of a needle’, as seen in the Phoenician pictogram **𐤎** of the letter and speaks of those who make it into the Kingdom of God through the narrow gate.

The word for ‘betrothal’ in Hebrew is **qiddushin/kiddushin**.

## *Definition of betrothal*

- formal engagement to be married; engagement

The **19th** book of the Old Testament is Psalms  
&  
The **19th** book of the New Testament is Hebrews

The **19th** chapter of The Revelation of Jesus Christ is The Second Coming of Jesus Christ to include:

The **marriage supper of the Lamb**  
&  
The **beast** and **false prophet**

## *Summary*

Man has a choice to choose **righteousness** or **wickedness** — **good** or **evil** — the **narrow** or **wide** path. Many of those who are turned in righteousness, placing their faith in Jesus Christ, during The Tribulation will be beheaded for refusing to worship the beast, his image, and receive his mark in an act of faith for their faith in Jesus Christ. In this way, they have been subdued as martyrs.

Thus, there are other elements to the KOPH, in that it sounds like the English word COUGH—as well as the COFF in COFFIN, that are comprised in the 19th letter of the Hebrew alphabet.
